In today's world of overbearing materialism, it can be very difficult to live out a spiritual life. So many distractions draw us ever further away from God and his holy church. A major influence on our spiritual lives is the gospel of T.V. A constant bombardment on the way we live our lives each day, is in complete contrast to the way GOD and his holy church teaches us. In these modern times it is possible our Catholic Faith could disappear amid the glitz and glamour of this world. To worship these things that do not speak to us, recognise us, or love us, is not religion. There are but two things in the whole universe, OUR OWN SOUL AND THE GOD WHO MADE IT. Perishable life disappears, riches fly away, and popularity is fickle, old friends die, the world changes. We all seek happiness, but few find it due to our quest for earth -bound things such as possession of wealth or power, or indulgence in the pleasures of the senses. It is true that we are weak and our powers are limited but, by means of prayer which unites us to a God of infinite power and love, we can obtain grace, which makes easy what otherwise would be too difficult or impossible. Many people shy away from the Christian way of life because it involves self-denial but, if people are prepared to submit themselves to great sacrifice for reasons of temporal security, why not for eternal security. We cannot live a Christian life without prayer. Yet we often pray with difficulty, distraction and complaint

We feel our prayers are not heard and do us no good. The reason for comments such as these is that prayer is often misunderstood. I believe we have the wrong idea of the principle of prayer and its fruits. We tend to judge prayers effectiveness by concrete, sensible, and immediate results, by the results produced for oneself or for others. If religion is to be devotion, and not to be a mere matter of sentiment. We must increase our knowledge of God before we can feel love, fear, hope, or trust towards him. The very idea of Christianity in its profession and history is a definite message from God to man, distinctly convey to us by his chosen instruments, to be positively embraced and acknowledged as true on the grounds of it being divine. If we allow ourselves to float down the current of the world, living as other men, gathering up our notions of religion here and there, as it may be, we have little or no true idea of a particular area. We conceive that Almighty God works on a large plan, but we cannot realize the wonderful truth that he sees and thinks of us as individuals. We cannot believe he is really present everywhere, that he is everywhere we are, though unseen. So as Catholics, do we ever ponder about what we will be judged on? The most significant act in the history of the human race has been passed down the centuries until this present day, the coming of our Lord and Savour Jesus Christ. What then was the reason for Christs suffering? Because He and only He was capable of paying the price of our freedom demanded by the will of the Lord our God. His passion restored to fallen mankind, what the original human race (ADAM & EVE) had lost by their disobedience, in that they sinned against God's law. In rejecting God, they began to love themselves and many other things more than they loved God, who must be first in everyone's hearts. By their actions they lost, not only for themselves, but for generations to come, the gift of eternal life. After the fall, human desires became more self-seeking and confused. With stronger guidance and greater support from the church many souls could be won back for our God. In the last one hundred years the church has become weak due to the disunity among the clergy who many themselves have become more worldly and less spiritual. Their failure to inform the people of the way they are living their lives, and the outcome of their actions will bring, to clearly explain the obligations of what it means being baptised a Catholic and the importance of what is expected of them. If people think that sin is trivial, and their commitment to God trifling. Take a good look at the crucifix. That is what God did for us, and that's what sin did to GOD. In most families today spiritual growth is almost nonexistent. It is as though the Catholic faith was living on borrowed time, especially in the west. This exodus can be slowed down if we seriously turn back to God.

To love God and one another will take a big effort on the part of those who do so. The clergy and the laity must stand up and speak the truth. To become united as one under God. Gods primary aim is the salvation of souls and it must be ours also. This world which has existed so long in the grip of fear, of dying, of suffering, poverty, of evil, it seems almost impossible to get our minds around a kingdom where none of these things exist. But that is a perfectly human reaction to the world in which we live. We are pressurised daily by the evils that surrounds us. I was told, many years ago, faith was believing in something you cannot understand. The love, beauty, joy, and happiness of heaven is not a myth or a fairy-tale. It is a reality. It is a mystery to be enjoyed, not to be analysed or understood, for there is nothing in this life that comes anywhere near the splendour of seeing God face to face. That is what we must strive to achieve, for ourselves and our families.

Sin - An Act of Evil

The reality of sin is in truth an Act of Evil. In today's modern world, the intensity of sin and its corruptions is widespread: immorality, pornography, idolatries, hopeless irreligion-all of this is a vision to appal and inflict on the mind a profound mystery, which is completely beyond human solution. One possible answer is, that either there is no God, or mankind is in a true sense discarded from his presence: Since there is a God, a God of love and mercy, then the human race is implicated in some terrible calamity, in fact it is out of joint with the purpose of its creator. The weak influential effect of the Church on the laity, man's utter inability to gain heaven by anything he can do himself, the moral certainty of losing his soul if left to himself. Our one great hope of gaining heaven is to place all our trust in Christ our Saviour and the Immaculate Heart of our Blessed Mother.

- (2) Commit oneself to a daily Rosary

The Church is not the inventor of the truth but the custodian of it. Christ reaches us today through his Sacraments. The Sacraments are the means to unite us to God. The Religion of the Pharisees is the Religion of Mankind

GOD'S MERCIFUL LOVE


